At times when the pharmaceutical sector is critically hit by the developments in the European financial environment, the Congress's principal subjects pertained to the enhancement of the pharmacist's scientific status and role in primary healthcare.

More than 200 pharmacists attended the Congress, which was addressed to pharmacists from the Prefectures of Serres, Drama, Kavala, Xanthi, Rodopi and Evros, but from other parts of the country as well.
